Who We Are/What We Do:

The Wayne Stinchcomb Big Orange Melanoma Foundation is a 501(c)3 foundation committed to raising melanoma awareness and generating donations for IRS registered charities that directly support melanoma research. Wayne Stinchcomb was a very vibrant and visible force who was diagnosed with melanoma at the age of 42 and in 2010, lost his three-year battle. His friends formed the Big Orange Foundation only months after his death. It consists of a volunteer board of directors comprised of healthcare and other professionals who have the desire and commitment to work towards the prevention and cure of melanoma. Through various fundraising efforts, the Big Orange Foundation has donated over \$270,000 to the Melanoma Research Alliance (MRA), the Maryland Melanoma Center at MedStar Franklin Square and the Cancer Support Foundation.

In recognition of our contributions to the MRA, a Young Investigator Award was named after Wayne Stinchcomb and awarded over three years to Rachel Vogel, The University of Minnesota – Twin Cities, for her pilot study of intervention to reduce sunburns in melanoma survivors.
